## Diverse work opportunities

Almost 20,000 people are employed in Dubbo. The City enjoys a lower unemployment rate than regional NSW: 4.9% (regional NSW) compared to 1.9% (Dubbo)in 2011.

The City's workforce represents a wide range of industries with a strong cross section of occupations.

The City has over 3500 businesses. The largest industry employer in Dubbo is the healthcare and social assistance sector, followed by retail, education and training, and public administration and safety.


## Higher education and training

There are several training, apprenticeship and pathways programs available through private and public organisations.


