Western Plains Regional Council is refurbishing the “welcome signs” located on the highway entrances to Dubbo. To help us do this we need fresh, exciting new designs!

Council is holding a competition open to students attending secondary school in Dubbo – years 7 – 12 - studying Visual Arts, Visual Arts Life Skills, Photography, Graphic Design, Digital Media or Visual Design.

4 winners will be selected and each win a fantastic package worth over \$1200!

We're looking for designs that are bold and vibrant, and that reflect the Dubbo brand, “time to smile”

Terms and conditions

- i. Competition open 4 July 2016 to 2 September 2016
- ii. Competition open to students attending secondary schools in Dubbo – years 7 – 12 - currently studying Visual Arts, Visual Arts Life Skills, Photography, Graphic Design, Digital Media or Visual Design
- iii. **Designs must be applied to the Rhino template (attached) and submitted electronically via email: citypromotions@dubbo.nsw.gov.au no later than 12 noon Friday 2 September 2016**
- iv. The submission may be a digital design or a photograph of a physical art work or design
- v. Western Plains Regional Council will not cover any expenses incurred by students in the process of developing a design concept
- vi. Submissions must be a digital .jpg file not larger than 1550x1100 pixels or 2MB
- vii. The submission should have a title, artist's name, school and contact details and be accompanied by a 100 word (limit) statement about the artist, their objectives or the design
- viii. Winners will be judged on the alignment of the design to Dubbo's brand, "time to smile". Judges will look favourably on designs that are unique, vibrant, and bold
- ix. All entries will be judged by a panel comprising a representative from Orana Arts, Dubbo Chamber of Commerce, Taronga Western Plains Zoo and local artist, Jack Randall
- x. Four winners will be announced week commencing 5 September 2016
- xi. Please note that the winning designs may be altered to fit the sculpture forms. The winning artist will receive a copy of the design prior to application by Jack Randall
- xii. Western Plains Regional Council reserves the right to determine the placement of the 4 winning designs
- xiii. Winning artists will be requested to be required to sign a Moral Rights Consent and Copyrights Consent form. (If you would like a copy of these forms, copies can be sent to you in advance to help in consideration of the terms and conditions)
- xiv. Submission of a design automatically provides approval to Western Plains Regional Council to provide to Taronga Western Plains Zoo to place on exhibition for 2 weeks at a future date to be determined
- xv. Design concepts not selected by the panel will remain the property of the artist and will not be used, represented or reproduced by Western Plains Regional Council (excepting the 2 week period that the entries are on exhibition at Taronga Western Plains Zoo)
- xvi. Each winner will received:
 - \$500 provided as a voucher for art supplies
 - Mentor Program with Jack Randall valued at \$720
 - 1 Family pass to a pre-determined Artlands Cultural Program event
 - 1 Family Pass (2 adults, 2 children) to Taronga Western Plains Zoo
- xvii. The winners will also be invited to observe various stages of the redevelopment and will also be invited to the media launch event
- xviii. Winners will be required to gain parent/guardian permission to partake in the mentoring program and complete any Work Health Safety requirements of the artist's (Jack Randall) workplace.
