Local Government

Western Plains Regional Council's Event Support and Development Program:

- Up to \$1,000 – applications open 1 July 2015 – 30 June 2016 [Not-for-profit events held in Dubbo, 1 July 2015 – 30 June 2016 are eligible to apply.]
- \$1,001 or more – applications re-open September 2016 [Not-for-profit events held in Dubbo, 1 January 2017 to 31 December 2017 will be eligible to apply.]
