By registering your business to participate in the Great Business Program, you agree to the following:

THE GREAT BUSINESS PROGRAM

The Great Business Program is an initiative of Dubbo Regional Council;

The administrator of the Program is Dubbo Regional Council, Civic Administration Building, Church Street Dubbo, phone 6801 4000;

Instructions on how to enter the Program form part of the conditions of entry;

By entering this Program, businesses agree to be bound by these terms and conditions (and by any other requirements set out in the promotional material) which may be amended or varied at any time by the administrator;

By entering this Program you agree to have your details published;

This Program will be handled in accordance with the Dubbo Regional Council Privacy Management Plan.

ELIGIBILITY

The Great Business Program is open to businesses trading in the Dubbo LGA only;

Minimum age of entrants is 18 years of age;

The Major Partner, Regional Australia Bank, may enter as a participating business in the Great Business Program but they are not eligible to win prize money for the business. Regional Australia Bank employees are encouraged to participate in the Business Development Workshops and customer feedback components of the Program. Regional Australia Bank employees are eligible to enter the 2 x \$2,500 Customer Draw when they make a valid entry.

Dubbo Regional Council businesses may enter as a participating business in the Great Business Program but they are not eligible to win prize money for the business. Dubbo Regional Council employees are encouraged to participate in the Business Development Workshops and customer feedback components of the Program, however are not eligible to enter the 2 x \$2,500 Customer Draw.

Businesses must complete the registration form in full and submit to Dubbo Regional Council through the Great Business Program website (www.greatbusinessprogram.com.au), by mail to PO BOX 81, Dubbo NSW 2830, email to council@dubbo.nsw.gov.au, or deliver in person to the Dubbo Civic Administration Building, Church Street Dubbo:

Payment of \$285 (GST inclusive) must be made upon receipt of invoice;

Registrations must be received by close of business Friday, 5 May 2017;

To be eligible for the Business Development Grant component of the Program, participating businesses must register and send a minimum of one staff member to <u>at least one</u> of the Great Business Program Workshop.

THE GRANTS

Three \$10,000 Business Development Grants are available through the Great Business Program.

Funding is provided as a grant and three successful applicants will each receive a cheque, posted by registered mail or delivered in person.

The condition of the grant money is that it must be spent "in or on" the registered business. Major partners and their families are not eligible to win the funding.

All registered businesses will receive details outlining what is required for the Business Development Grant Application.

Applications will be reviewed separately by a panel of three regionally-based industry representatives.

Applications will be assessed as outlined in the 'Business Development Grant Application Form'

The panel's decision is final and no further correspondence will be entered into.

The business improvement/expansion ideas from the successful applicants will be made public.

Applications will not be made public.

Successful applicants will be asked to provide a follow-up to Dubbo Regional Council regarding the expenditure of funds and impact on the business.

TIMING

Registrations for the Great Business Program open 9am, Wednesday 12 April 2017 and close 5pm, Friday 5 May 2017;

The Great Business Development Workshops will be conducted throughout May 2017.

The Great Business Program Consumer Promotion commences at 9am, Friday 2 June 2017 and concludes at close of business on Monday, 10 July 2017.

Applications for a Business Development Grant must be received by 5pm, Tuesday 20 July 2017.

SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION OF WINNER

The winning businesses will be determined by an independent panel of judges. The panel's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Each Business Development Grant application will be judged against a set criteria relating to knowledge of their market environment, use of customer insight, and creativity:

There are three \$10,000 Business Development Grants available for three participating businesses in the Great Business Program. The Grants must be used on the winners' businesses;

The three winning businesses will be announced in early August 2017 at a time and location to be advised:

If the winner is not in attendance, they will be notified by phone and mail within two days of the annuancement:

If the winner is in attendance, they will be presented with a cheque at the time of the announcement;

The winning businesses will be announced publicly through the Dubbo Regional Council Twitter and Facebook networks, websites www.dubbo.nsw.gov.au and www.greatbusinessprogram.com.au and in any publicity relating to the promotion.

Feedback will be collated and individual results will be provided directly to registered businesses;
