Dubbo’s central location has been a great advantage to Newtown Providores, enabling the business to prosper beyond the setting of Dubbo. The business services a great portion of the state from Bourke to Wilcannia and right through to Tamworth.

“We’ve been embraced completely by the community of Dubbo and also the communities that Dubbo services,” Peter said.

“Part of the reason we do quite well is that we promote and assist any charity or organisation, even outside of Dubbo. We put a lot of emphasis on zipping out to little places where you know you’re not going to turn enough money to actually make it viable, but to support their events and build their events and help their community by investing in their community.”

The exclusive food store is popular with tourists and constantly receives requests to open up shop in Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane and Newcastle because customers can’t get what is on offer in a one-stop-shop anywhere else.
