Diverse work opportunities

Over 21,000 people are employed in Dubbo, with employment in the City enjoying higher annual growth than New South Wales: 2.7% compared to 1.9% in December 2008.

The City's workforce represents a wide range of industries with a strong cross section of occupations.

The City has around 3500 businesses. The largest industry employer in Dubbo is the retail sector, followed by healthcare and the social assistance sector, education and training, and manufacturing.

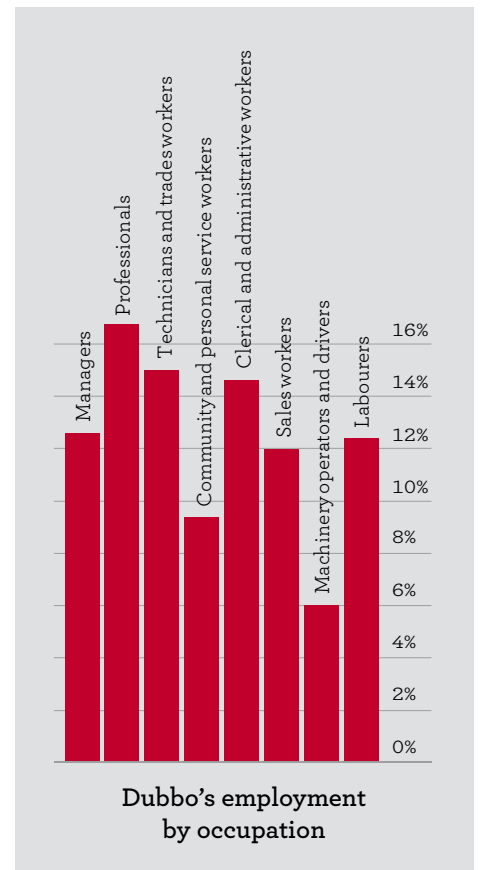
Higher education and training

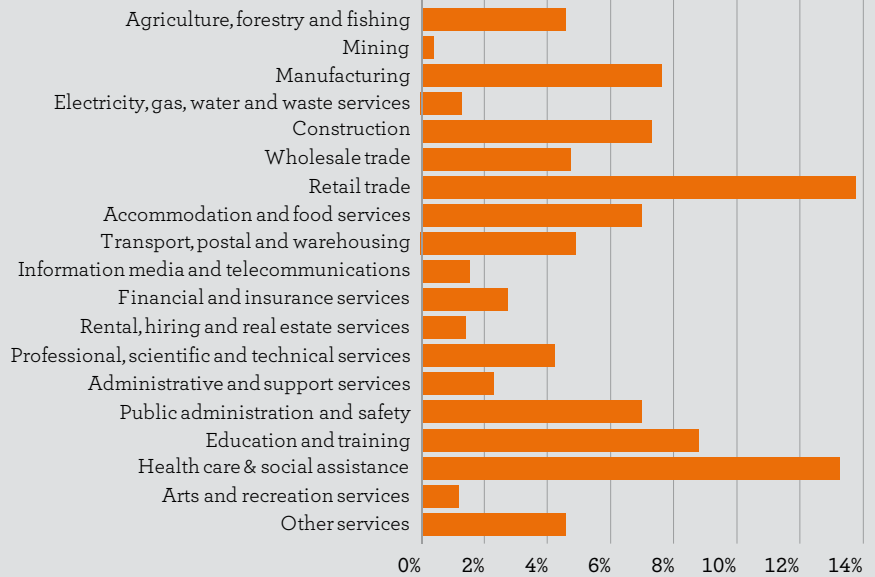
