Evocities Update

Since its launch in September 2010, the Evocities campaign has attracted 93,659 visits to evocities.com.au and 89,707 visits to evojobs.com.au. The campaign has received 1,175 media appearances reaching over 14.8 million people. Equivalent value of this coverage is over \$4M. Between September 2010 and August 2011, Dubbo received 818 prospective new resident enquiries with 65 confirmed as relocated. Some 48 plan to move and another 48 are considering a move to Dubbo.
