

Introduction

The What's On is a forum to be used by locals and visitors to gain information about what is on in Dubbo. The website showcases but is not limited to events such as conferences, festivals, shows, fetes, sporting activities, exhibitions and concerts. Listing your event on dubbo.com.au is free to event organisers although terms and conditions apply as follows.

Terms and Conditions

- Must be held in Dubbo LGA
- Event organisers are responsible for uploading their event to dubbo.com.au.
- All details must be finalised by the event organiser or authorised agent – all details must be finalised including cost, location etc
- Dubbo City Council has the right to upload events deemed to be of significant interest to the community or expected to draw large numbers of visitors. (This helps to reduce incident of “event clashes” and aids in the overall promotion of Dubbo as an event venue eg Claim the Date Events)
- Events must have the appropriate local government, police and traffic approvals (where applicable). If not, Dubbo City Council will not agree to promote the event.
- Regular classes such as dance, language, music or art classes are not eligible
- Attractions that include phrases such as ‘tours every weekend’, ‘open over Easter’, ‘as part of the events calendar’ or ‘races nightly’ are generally not eligible.
- Fund-raisers, sporting fund-raisers, charity functions, trade shows, promotional and general commercial activities and competitions will be carefully reviewed against the criteria and may not be regarded as eligible
- Council makes every effort to avoid errors in events listings. However, Council accepts no responsibility or liability for any errors and requires that organisers check their events listing for errors as soon as they are placed on the site(s). Any errors may be edited by the administrator on the advice of the event organiser.
- Council reserves the right to either reject or remove any event listing from its site(s) for any reason whatsoever.
- Council is not liable for any loss or damage incurred by an event organiser as a result of any failure or delay in listing an event.
- Your event may also be published in print or promoted on local radio.

Council will not agree to list an event if it perceives the event:

- Conflicts with Council's values, policies or statutory responsibilities
- Promotes politicians or political parties
- Involves the manufacture, distribution and sale of tobacco and tobacco-related products
- Involves the manufacture, distribution and wholesaling of alcoholic products to youth or children and families.
- Are otherwise of a nature that Council determines is likely to affect Council's public image or reputation adversely.
- The event is considered to be primarily about a commercial entity or business promotion
- All care is taken to ensure event listings contain accurate and up to date information but the responsibility for such content belongs to the content contributors.

Event cancellation or Significant Change

- An event organiser must immediately notify Dubbo City Council after it becomes aware that an event has been or is likely to be cancelled or is subject to a significant change to the information supplied
